The Artists in the Schools (AIS) program places professional artists in schools to work directly with students and teachers. The program encourages a high level of participation in all grades, with emphasis on understanding the processes of creating and responding to art. Manitoban artists share their perceptions and skills, and at the same time develop in schools an awareness of the potential of arts education.

There are two programs AIS: Short-Term Residencies (5 days) and Long-Term Residencies (10 days or more.) As of July 1, 2004, the School Readings program is being administered by the Manitoba Writers' Guild. In line with Council priorities, over two-thirds of AIS and Young Audience Touring program activity takes place in northern, remote and rural schools.

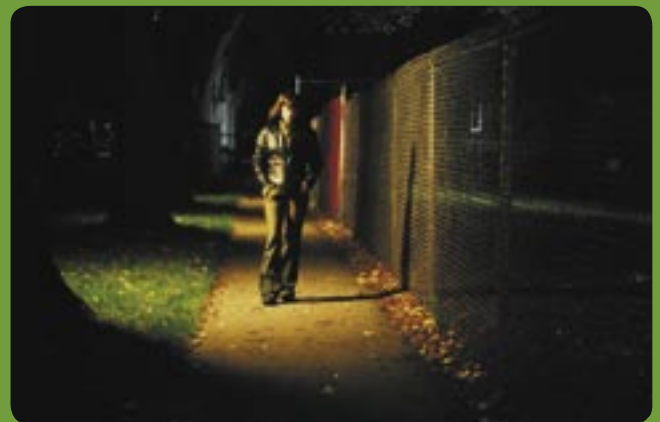

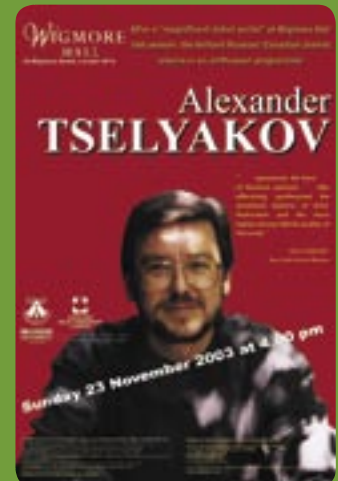
